South Mokanger Farm Cottages Cavendish

DIRECTIONS TO **STONEYCROFT COTTAGE AND MOUNTAIN DUCK COTTAGE** **FROM MELBOURNE**

Depending where you live in Melbourne I find that this way is now the fastest with an option of going through Ballarat if you wish, for shopping, food or petrol. From the city I go via the Westgate Bridge, onto the Western Ring Road (M80) turning off onto the Western Freeway to Ballarat/Fitzgerald Rd. Continue to Ballarat where you can take the first exit and go to the centre of Ballarat or if you are happy to go straight through stay on the Freeway by-passing Ballarat and travel on to Beaufort. 8k's through Beaufort take the left turn sign posted to Streatham. This road goes straight through about 38 k's where you come to a cross road and you turn right onto the Glenelg Highway to Streatham. From here you continue on to Dunkeld. (*If you go into Ballarat I suggest you drive up Sturt St toward the Arch turning left into Learmonth St just before it. This becomes Wiltshire Lane, which you stay on to a 'T' intersection where you turn right onto the Glenelg Highway and so through to Skipton and Dunkeld.*) About 3 K's past Dunkeld turn right onto the Cavendish road. Travel 20 k's to a crossroad and turn right into Gardners Road. Follow to a 'T' intersection, turn left, **SOUTH MOKANGER** is the first house on the **LEFT**. Please come to our house and we'll direct you to your Cottage. Should we not be home, then about two hundred metres on, past our letter box, on the *same side* is a sign and farm gate that leads into **STONEYCROFT COTTAGE** which you'll find by taking the right fork in the road to the right of the big Bluestone woolshed. **MOUNTAIN DUCK COTTAGE** is also on the same side as us but a little further on down the road from the **STONEYCROFT** sign. Your cottage will have been prepared for you, and we will catch up as soon as we get home. Should you be traveling late at night (and bypass Ballarat) you may find it difficult to buy food on this route, either Beaufort or Skipton, being the last large roadhouse for food or petrol.
